The Agency for Health Care Administration Final Order in DOAH Case Numbers 12-0424CON, and 12-0427CON, dated March 14, 2012, requires the issuance of Certificate of Need Number 10132 to The Shores Behavioral Hospital, LLC to establish a 12-bed adult substance abuse program at The Shores Behavioral Hospital in Broward County, District 10.

Rules pertinent to the CON review process include Rules 59C-1.002 through 59C-1.030 Florida Administrative Code and the rule specific to your proposed program (i.e. 59C-1.0355 for hospice, 59C-1.036 for nursing facility beds, etc). If your project involves licensed beds, the application must identify the number of beds to be converted, added, or delicensed.

The application filing fee is \$10,000.00 plus 0.015 times the total project cost up to a maximum fee of \$50,000.00. The minimum fee for projects with no capital expenditure is \$10,000.00. The non-refundable filing fee should be submitted with the application on or before the application due date listed above. 
